### K-Taping & IASTM Procedure Flow

## Kinesio-Taping

- 1. Rule out adhesive allergy contraindication with test strip of tape
- 2. Clean the skin; trim hair, do not shave
- 3. Measure tape for target tissue length
- 4. Cut tape to length and round the edges
- 5. Tear off backing 1 2 inches at each end of the tape; these sections will become the anchors
- 6. Apply an anchor with no tension
- 7. Apply to skin with appropriate tension/position
- 8. Apply the second anchor with no tension
- 9. Rub tape to activate the adhesive

#### **IASTM**

Ensure the patient is free of contraindications prior to all procedures being performed

- Assess the patient movement screen
- 2. Clean/disinfect the instruments using antimicrobial solution
- 3. Warm the tissues to be treated hot pack, exercise, etc...
- Apply gloves
- 5. Use a tongue depressor to apply emollient to skin (depending on technique) to limit exposure to microbes
- 6. Scan and treat soft tissues using clean instruments
- 7. Clean emollient off patient
- 8. Clean/disinfect instruments using antimicrobial solution
- 9. Dispose of gloves appropriately
- Reassess the patient movement screen
